

NORTH DAKOTA IDs FOR VOTING

Voting in-person requires a North Dakota:

- Current driver's license or non-driver's ID card
- Tribal government issued ID **OR**
- Long-term care ID certificate (provided by ND facility)

Identification must include the voter's:

- Name
- Current residential address
- Date of birth

In addition to your ID, you can supplement any missing or outdated voter info with:

- Current utility bill
- Current bank statement
- Document or check issued by a federal, state, local, or tribal government
- Paycheck
