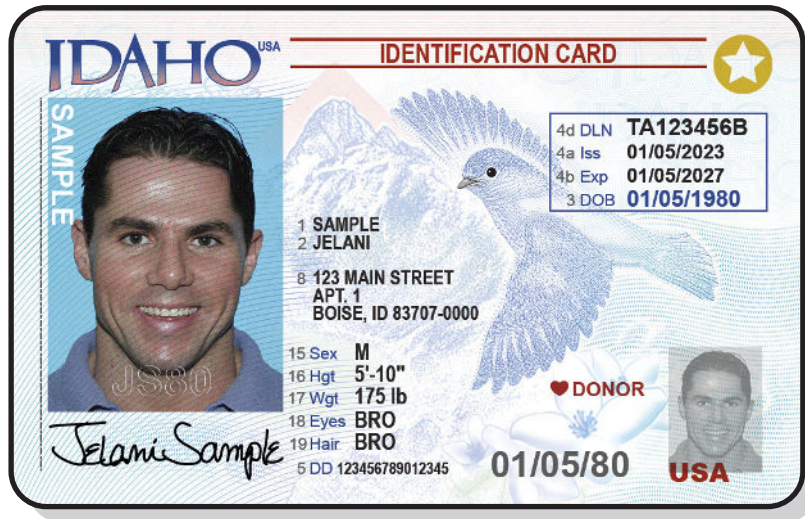


Free ID for Voting



Idahoans who need a free ID card for voting can visit a county DMV office to get their card. They must meet the following requirements:

- The applicant is at least eighteen (18) years of age at the time of application.
- The applicant has not possessed a valid driver's license for at least six (6) months prior to application.
- Subsequently acquiring a driver's license will end the free ID renewals and the one-time free replacement. They will not be required to surrender their ID card.
- The applicant indicates the identification card is needed for voting purposes on the application.
- Has proof of being a US citizen or the DMV has scanned records of US citizenship on file.

Additionally, applicants who obtain a free ID for voting purposes, are entitled to one (1) free replacement and free renewals as long as they continue to meet these requirements.

The free ID for voting is the same as the standard Idaho Identification Card, just offered at no charge to eligible applicants.

Like all Idaho driver's licenses and ID cards, the applicant needs to bring proof of Idaho residency (lease or rental agreements, utility bills, school enrollment records, etc.) and proof of age and identity (birth certificate, passport, naturalization documents, etc.).
