ID must have your name

You can show a photo ID:

Must be unexpired.

- · Driver's license
- State ID card
- Student ID
- Employee ID
- Tribal ID
- · US passport or passport card
- Military ID

If you don't bring ID, sign a form (called a Polling Place Elector ID form).

You can show a non-photo ID with an address:

Must be current.

- Voter registration confirmation
- Utility bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- Government check
- Government document
