

South Carolina requests photo ID to vote in person.

ID must have your name and photo

You can show:

- SC driver's license
- SC state ID card
- US passport or passport card
- Military ID issued by US government
- SC Concealed Weapons Permit

If you don't have ID:

1. Show your voter registration card
2. Sign a form (called a reasonable impediment statement)
3. Vote by provisional ballot
