Virginia requests ID to vote in person.

You can use a VA driver's license even if it is expired.

You can also show:

Can be expired up to 12 months.

- VA state ID card
- US passport
- ID issued by US, VA, or local government
- VA Voter ID card
- Military ID
- Employee ID
- Tribal ID issued by tribe recognized by VA

- Voter confirmation documents
- Student ID issued by high school in VA
- Student ID issued by US institution of higher education
- Copy of current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document

If you don't bring ID, sign a form (called an ID Confirmation Statement).
