 **VOTERIDERS**

In Washington you do not need ID to vote by mail
except for some first-time voters

To vote in person, you are asked to sign a form or show photo ID

To vote in person, Washington asks you to sign a form or show photo ID.

ID must have your name and photo.

- Sign a form (called a ballot declaration) to confirm your identity

Or, you can show photo ID like :

- Driver's license
- State ID card
- Student ID
- Tribal ID
- US passport or passport card
- Employee ID
