

# TEXAS IDS FOR VOTING

**Cast a regular ballot if you present acceptable photo ID:**

- Texas Driver's License
- Texas Personal ID Card
- Texas Election ID Certificate
- Handgun License
- Military ID Card
- US Passport Book or Card
- US Citizenship Certificate (does not expire)

Your ID must be unexpired or expired up to 4 years.  
Voters age 70 or older may use ID expired 4+ years.

**If you do not have one of the above, then show one of the following:**

- Voter Registration Certificate
- Certified U.S. Birth Certificate
- Current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government document (e.g. check, employee ID, out-of-state license) with your name and ANY address

**AND complete and sign a reasonable impediment declaration.**

An election officer is not permitted to question the reasonableness of your impediment to getting an ID.
