

# UTAH IDs FOR VOTING

**First-time UT voters must provide a copy of your unexpired UT driver license or ID card. Otherwise:**

**ONE ID with voter's name & photo, including:**

- UT driver's license#
  - ID card issued by UT or an entity of U.S.#
  - UT concealed weapon permit#
  - U.S. passport#
  - U.S. military ID card#
  - Tribal ID (needn't include photo)#
- # must be current

---

**OR**

**TWO IDs with voter's name & evidence voter resides in voting precinct, including:**

- Utility bill dated within 90 days of election
  - Bank or other financial account statement
  - Certified birth certificate
  - Social Security card
  - Check issued by UT or U.S. government
  - Paycheck from your employer
  - UT hunting or fishing license#
  - License issued by U.S. authorized agency#
  - Certified naturalization documentation
  - Certified court records: adoption or name change
  - Medicaid, Medicare, or Electronic Benefits Transfer card
  - ID issued by UT local government or employer#
  - ID issued by post-secondary school in UT#
  - UT vehicle registration#
- # must be current
