



GUIDE TO VOTER ID RULES IN WISCONSIN

REGISTERED VOTERS MUST PRESENT ID AT THE POLLS TO VOTE

THE FOLLOWING IDS ARE ACCEPTABLE IF THEY INCLUDE YOUR PHOTO AND NAME:

- Wisconsin driver's license (OK if expired after November 3, 2020)
- Wisconsin state ID (OK if expired after November 3, 2020)
- U.S. military ID card (OK if expired after November 3, 2020)
- U.S. Passport (OK if expired after November 3, 2020)
- Veterans Affairs Card (Unexpired or without expiration date)
- Wisconsin tribal ID card (Can be unexpired or expired)
- Certificate of Naturalization (Issued within 2 years of voting)
- Wisconsin DMV ID Petition Process Photo Receipt (valid for 60 days from date issued)
- ID issued by a Wisconsin accredited university, college, or technical college that includes:
 - the date the card was issued
 - the signature of the student
 - an expiration date no later than 2 years after date issued (if ID is expired, you must also show proof of enrollment)
