GUIDE TO VOTER ID RULES IN PENNSYLVANIA

VOTING IN PERSON

When you vote for the first time in your precinct, you need to show an acceptable ID.

Other Pennsylvania voters **do not** need to present an ID to vote.

Acceptable Photo IDs:

- Current Pennsylvania driver's license
- Current PennDOT ID card
- ID issued by Pennsylvania Commonwealth
- ID issued by US government
- US Passport
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Employee ID

OR

Non-photo ID with your name and address:

- Voter Registration Card
- ID issued by Pennsylvania Commonwealth
- ID issued by US government
- Firearm permit
- Current utility bill, bank statement or paycheck

VOTING BY MAIL: Provide ID information or a copy of an acceptable ID when you apply for your ballot.
You can use: Pennsylvania Driver's License or PennDOT ID number, Social Security number, or copy of ID listed above
