

Voter ID Rules



Voting in Person

Acceptable Photo IDs

ID must be current and show your signature:

- Florida driver's license
- Florida state ID
- U.S. Passport
- Debit or credit card
- U.S. military ID
- Student ID
 - County determines validity if student ID has no expiration date.
- Neighborhood association ID
- Public assistance ID
- Retirement center ID
- Veterans health ID card
- License to carry concealed weapon or firearm
- Employee ID card issued by Federal Government or Florida state/county/municipality

Note: If your photo ID has no signature, bring additional ID that does have signature.



Voting by Mail

When you apply for a vote-by-mail ballot, you will need to provide one of the following:

- Florida driver's license number
- Florida state ID number
- Last 4 digits of Social Security number

New in 2023!



Florida voters who wish to vote by mail for the 2023 and 2024 elections must submit a new ballot request.
