

Voter ID Rules



Voting in Person

You must show an acceptable photo ID.



Voting by Mail

You must include a copy of an acceptable photo ID with your first absentee ballot request.

Acceptable Photo IDs

Ok if expired after 11/08/2022:

Wisconsin driver's license

Wisconsin state ID

U.S. military ID card

U.S. Passport

Student IDs must:

Be from institution accredited by WI

Show your signature

Show issue and expiration date

Expire within 2 years of issue date

Note: If your student ID is expired, you must also show proof of enrollment!

Other acceptable photo IDs:

Veterans Affairs Card

Unexpired or without expiration date

Wisconsin tribal ID card

Unexpired or expired

Certificate of Naturalization

Issued within 2 years of voting

DMV ID Petition Process Photo Receipt

Valid for 60 days from date issued



Spring Election

Deadline to register online or by mail:
March 15, 2023

Register in person through Election Day!
