In North Carolina you are asked to show a photo ID to vote in person

North Carolina requests photo ID to vote in person.

ID must have your name and photo

Most people show:

Can be expired 1 year (longer after your 65th birthday).

- NC driver's license or ID card
- US passport or passport card
- NC county Voter ID card
- Student ID issued by schools approved by NC BOE
- Government employee ID approved by NC BOE
- Driver's license or ID card issued by any state (only voters who register within 90 days of election)

You can also show:

No expiration date required.

- Military ID issued by US
- Veteran health ID card issued by VA
- Tribal enrollment card issued by tribe recognized by state or US government

If you don't have ID, sign a form (called a Photo ID Exception Form).
