NEVADA

ID is <u>NOT</u> required for most Nevada voters.

Voting for the first time in a federal election:

- Voter registration requires one of the following (in order):
 - 1. Current driver's license number
 - 2. Current state ID number
 - 3. Last 4 digits of Social Security number
 - 4. Apply for state-assigned number
 - If you don't provide this info, be prepared to present one of the following to vote:
 - current photo ID
 - current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government document showing your name and address
 - copy of the above if voting by mail
