New voter ID law in effect 2023!

North Carolina voters will be asked to show an acceptable photo ID to cast a regular ballot.

The following IDs must be unexpired or expired less than one year. ID can be expired for more time after your 65th birthday:

- NC driver's license
- NC state ID card
- US Passport book or card
- NC Voter ID issued by county
- Student ID from school approved by NC Board of Elections
- Government employee ID approved by NC Board of Elections
- Driver's license or ID card issued by any state (only voters who register within 90 days of election)

No issuance or expiration date required for:

- Military ID issued by US government
- Veterans ID issued by VA
- Tribal enrollment card

Don't have an acceptable ID? You can still vote if you complete and sign an ID exception form!
