

## Voter ID Rules



### Voting in Person

Arizona voters must present acceptable ID:

- 1 One photo ID
  - AZ driver's license
  - AZ state ID
  - Tribal ID
  - Government-issued ID  
U.S. federal, state, or local

**OR**

- 2 Two forms of ID without photo
  - Utility bill
  - Recent bank or credit union statement
  - Tribal ID
  - AZ vehicle registration or insurance card
  - Property tax statement
  - Recorder's certificate
  - Voter registration card
  - Government-issued ID  
U.S. federal, state, or local
  - Any item of mail labeled  
"official election material"

#### All IDs must:

- Be unexpired or show no expiration
- Show name and address that reasonably match voter registration

Note: If your photo ID lacks an address or shows a different one, bring an ID from the non-photo list with your correct address!
